In order to resolve this matter, the Nebraska Department of Insurance ("Department"), by and through its attorney, Robert M. Bell, and Crop Pro Ins Services Inc ("Crop Pro") and GuideOne Mutual Insurance Company ("GuideOne") (collectively referred to as "Respondents") mutually stipulate and agree as follows:

JURISDICTION

- 1. The Department has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Respondents pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-101.01 and 44-135, the Insurance Producers Licensing Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4047 to 4067, and the Managing General Agent Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4901 to 44-4910.
- Crop Pro is a licensed nonresident insurance producer and managing general agent under the laws of Nebraska and GuideOne is an Iowa domiciled insurer licensed to do business in Nebraska at all times material hereto.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

- 1. The Department initiated this administrative proceeding by filing a Petition and Notice of Hearing captioned State of Nebraska Department of Insurance vs. Crop Pro Ins Services Inc (NAIC National Producer #18491323) and GuideOne Mutual Insurance Company (NAIC #15032), Cause No. A-2165, on December 19, 2018.
- 2. The Department mailed a copy of the Petition and Notice of Hearing to the Crop Pro's registered address with the Department, 5435 NW 100th Suite 200, Johnston, IA 50131, by certified mail, return receipt requested, and by email to Crop Pro's registered email address agencyservices@croppro.com.
- 3. The Department mailed a copy of the Petition and Notice of Hearing to the GuideOne's registered address 1111 Ashworth Rd, West Des Moines, IA, 50265-3538.
 - 4. Respondents received a copy of the petition and notice of hearing.
- 5. The Petition alleges that Respondents violated Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4059(1) as follows: In or about February through May 2018, Respondent Crop Pro did not sufficiently limit sales of Production Plan Hail insurance in Nebraska and failed to receive confirmation of reinsurance in a timely manner, resulting in Crop Pro cancelling 367 Nebraska insurance policies.
- 6. Respondents were informed of their right to a public hearing. Respondents waive that right and enter into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily. Respondents understand and acknowledge that by waiving the right to a public hearing, Respondents are also waiving their right to confrontation of witnesses, production of evidence, and judicial review.
- 7. In the spirit of cooperation with the Department, Respondents are willing to resolve all pending matters to avoid the uncertainty and expense of litigation.

Respondents voluntarily agree to the settle this matter by agreeing to the terms of this Consent Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Crop Pro violated Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4059(1) and is subject to disciplinary action pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4059. Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4907, Crop Pro's actions are considered the actions of GuideOne.

CONSENT ORDER

It is therefore ordered by the Director of Insurance and agreed by Crop Pro Ins Services Inc and GuideOne Mutual Insurance Company that:

- Crop Pro agrees to pay an administrative penalty of \$50,000 within 15 days
 after the Director or his designee approves and signs this Consent Order.
 Failure to pay the fine will result in immediate administrative action against Crop
 Pro.
- GuideOne agrees to pay an administrative penalty of \$10,000 within 15 days
 after the Director or his designee approves and signs this Consent Order.
 Failure to pay the fine will result in immediate administrative action against
 GuideOne.
- 3. Crop Pro agrees that it will allow its Nebraska insurance producer and managing general agent licenses to expire on April 30, 2019, and that Crop Pro will not reapply for an insurance producer license or managing general agent license for at least five years after the date the Director signs this Consent Order. This voluntary exit from Nebraska also extends to any successor

entities of Crop Pro and business entities of which Crop Pro's executives, William Rose and/or Joseph Young, are owners or executives.

The Department of Insurance will continue to retain jurisdiction over this matter. In witness of their intention to be bound by this Consent Order, the parties have executed this document by subscribing their signatures below.
