In order to resolve this matter, the Nebraska Department of Insurance ("Petitioner"), by and through its attorney, Michael W. Anderson, and Scott Cameron ("Respondent"), by and through his attorney, Jordan Adam, mutually stipulate and agree as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. Petitioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Respondent pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44.101.01, and 44-4047 to 44-4067.
2. Respondent has been licensed as a resident insurance producer under the laws of Nebraska at all times material hereto.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. Petitioner initiated this administrative proceeding by filing a Petition captioned State of Nebraska Department of Insurance vs. Scott Cameron (NAIC National Producer #19088403), Cause Number A-2384 on May 16, 2024. A copy of the Petition was sent to the Respondent at his registered address by certified mail, return receipt requested, and by regular U.S. mail. A copy of the petition was also emailed to the Respondent at scottcameron@cox.net. Respondent acknowledges receiving proper Notice of these proceedings.
2. Respondent is alleged to have violated Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(h) as follows:

- a. On or about January 2, 2024, Respondent made representations to a potential policyholder that a prior Zoom communication between them had been recorded.
- b. It was subsequently discovered that a Zoom recording did not exist and that the meeting between the Respondent and the potential policyholder had not been recorded.

3. Respondent disputes the allegations in Paragraph 2 above; however, Respondent agrees, without admission, that the allegations in Paragraph 2 would constitute a violation of certain language in Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(h).

4. Respondent was informed of his right to a public hearing. Respondent waives that right and enters into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily. Respondent understands and acknowledges that by waiving his right to a public hearing, Respondent also waives his right to confrontation of witnesses, production of evidence, and judicial review.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct as alleged above constitutes a violation of one or more parts of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(h), and Respondent is subject to disciplinary action pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §44-4059.

CONSENT ORDER

It is therefore Ordered by the Director of Insurance and agreed by Respondent that:

1. Respondent agrees to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$1,000.

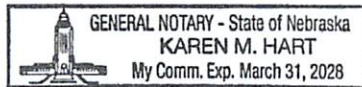


