In order to resolve this matter, the Nebraska Department of Insurance (“Petitioner”), by and through its attorney, Cheryl Wolff, and William A. Dickens (“Respondent”), (NAIC Producer #16352895), mutually stipulate and agree as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. Petitioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Respondent pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44.101.01, and 44-4047 to 44-4067.
2. Respondent has been licensed as a non-resident insurance producer under the laws of Nebraska at all times material hereto.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. Petitioner initiated this administrative proceeding by filing a Petition captioned State of Nebraska Department of Insurance vs. William A. Dickens (“Respondent”) (NAIC Producer #16352895), Cause Number A-2556 on December 3, 2025. A copy of the Petition was sent to the Respondent to his registered business, residential and mailing address on file with the Department at

1700 LAKECLIFFE DR #C, WHEATON, Illinois 60189, and to his registered business and personal email address at [will.dickens@gmail.com](mailto:will.dickens@gmail.com). Respondent acknowledges receiving proper Notice of these proceedings.

2. Respondent is alleged to have violated Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(b),(d),(h),(i), and (o) and 44-4065(1) as follows:

a) Respondent failed to maintain a resident insurance license in his home state of Illinois.

Respondent's Illinois resident license became inactive on May 1, 2025. Additionally, the Illinois Department of Insurance denied the Respondent a license on November 7, 2025, for failure to file and pay Illinois state income taxes for tax years 2014-2024.

b) Respondent also had administrative actions taken against his producer licenses in Alaska, Ohio, Idaho, and Arizona as follows:

a. The Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development Division of Insurance suspended the Respondent's license effective April 1, 2025, for fraud and consumer misrepresentation which included the misappropriation of premiums for Respondent's personal use in excess of \$1,600.

b. The Ohio Department of Insurance ("ODOI") Agent's request to Surrender for Cause document completed and effective on July 1, 2025. In this document, the Respondent admitted to being under investigation by ODOI, that he failed to maintain a resident license, that he had actions against his license in another state, and was accused of fraud and misrepresentations on an application for insurance.

c. The Idaho Department of Insurance revocation of the Respondent's non-resident license on September 19, 2025, for failing to maintain a valid resident license in good standing.

- d. The Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions revoked the Respondent's non-resident license effective December 8, 2025, for demonstrated lack of fitness or trustworthiness, failure to maintain adequate books and records, and failure to report other state actions.
- c) Respondent did not notify the Department of the administrative actions noted above within 30 days of the final disposition of each matter.
3. Respondent admits the allegations in Paragraph 2.
4. Respondent was informed of his right to a public hearing. Respondent waives that right and enters into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily. Respondent understands and acknowledges that by waiving his right to a public hearing, Respondent also waives his right to confrontation of witnesses, production of evidence, and judicial review.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct as alleged above constitutes violations of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1) b),(d),(h),(i), and (o) and 44-4065(1), and Respondent is subject to disciplinary action pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §44-4059.

#### CONSENT ORDER

It is therefore Ordered by the Director of Insurance and agreed upon by the Respondent that:

1. Respondent agrees to surrender his Nebraska insurance producer license in order to fully resolve this matter and avoid further litigation.
