Chapter 35 - UNFAIR DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF BLINDNESS OR PARTIAL BLINDNESS

<u>001. Statutory authority</u>. This Rule is promulgated pursuant to the authority granted by <u>Neb.Rev.Stat</u>. §44-101.01 and §44-1533.

<u>002. Purpose</u>. The purpose of this Rule is to identify specific acts or practices which are prohibited by <u>Neb.Rev.Stat</u>. §44-1525(7)(a) and (b).

<u>003. Unfairly discriminatory acts or practices.</u> The following are hereby identified as acts or practices which constitute unfair discrimination between individuals of the same class: refusing to insure, or refusing to continue to insure, or limiting the amount, extent or kind of coverage available to an individual or charging an individual a different rate for the same coverage solely because of blindness or partial blindness.
