The Department of Insurance, by and through counsel, Michael W. Anderson, hereby orders Arias Agencies, in conjunction with American Income Life ("Arias") to immediately CEASE AND DESIST issuing, making, providing, selling or offering, either directly or indirectly, insurance plans in the State of Nebraska. This authority is exercised pursuant to *Neb. Rev. Stat.* §§ 44-101.01, 44-135, and 44-2002.

- The Department of Insurance is a duly designated agency of the state of Nebraska with authority to exercise general supervision, control and regulation of the business of insurance in Nebraska.
- 2. Arias alleges to be an insurer offering insurance products to consumers in the State of Nebraska.
- 3. The Department has reason to believe that Arias, by and through its agents, is engaging in the unauthorized business of insurance in Nebraska and/or has or continues to operate as a producer agency within this state that has failed to register as such with the Department of Insurance, to wit:
  - a. The Department of Insurance received a complaint in July of 2020 regarding Facebook posts made by Robert Jackson and Dylan Geer, both employees of Arias Agencies, offering \$100 incentives for referrals for life insurance policies.

b. In reviewing this matter, it was discovered that Arias was not registered in the State of Nebraska as a non-resident agency, and that the resident agency license held by Arias in Pennsylvania was not active. Arias, as an unregistered agency,

was also found to be operating without a designated licensed responsible

producer.

d. According to records of the Department of Insurance, Arias does not have a certificate of authority to operate as an insurer in the State of Nebraska as

required under Neb. Rev. Stat. §44-2002.

e. According to records of the Department of Insurance, Arias has not registered

to operate as a foreign insurance company pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §44-135.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Arias and its representatives,

immediately CEASE AND DESIST from further issuing, making, providing, selling, or offering

to sell to Nebraska residents, either directly through individuals or indirectly through the mail,

including the taking or receiving membership fees or other consideration or any portion thereof,

for Arias or other insurance products which are not directly insured by an insurer holding a

Certificate of Authority to transact said business in this state and any and all insurance products

they are advertising, soliciting, or marketing in this State. Within ten days after service of this

cease and desist order, Arias may request a hearing on the question of whether an action or practice

in violation of the act has occurred. Such hearing shall be conducted as provided by the

Administrative Procedure Act.
