In order to resolve this matter, the Nebraska Department of Insurance ("Department"), by and through its attorney, Tracy A. Burns, and Trisha A. Wiehl, ("Respondent"), by and through her attorney, Richard E. Dietz, mutually stipulate and agree as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. The Department has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Respondent pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-101.01 and the Insurance Producers Licensing Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4047 to 4069.
2. Respondent is a licensed non-resident insurance producer under the laws of Nebraska at all times material hereto.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. The Department initiated this administrative proceeding by filing a Petition and Notice of Hearing captioned State of Nebraska Department of Insurance vs. Trisha A. Wiehl, NAIC National Producer #8830747, Cause A-2132, on September 12, 2018.
2. The Department mailed a copy of the Petition and Notice of Hearing to the home

address Respondent registered with the Department, 21012 Q Rd., Smith Center, KS 66967-6509, by certified mail, return receipt requested. Respondent received a copy of the Petition and Notice of Hearing and notified her attorney, Richard E. Dietz.

3. The Petition alleges that Respondent violated Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(h), 44-4-59(1)(i) and 44-4059(1)(o) as a result of the following conduct:

- a. On or about August 28, 2018, Respondent was arrested and charged in Smith County, Kansas District Court with one count of insurance fraud, one count of theft, and thirty-five counts of making false information.
- b. The above-described criminal charges are pending as of the date of this Consent Order.
- c. An Emergency Ex Parte Order suspending the Respondent's Kansas Resident Insurance Agent's License was entered by the Kansas Insurance Commissioner's Office on August 30, 2018.
- d. The Respondent has voluntarily surrendered her Kansas resident license.

4. The above described conduct demonstrates using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Nebraska or elsewhere; this constitutes a violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4059(1)(h).

5. The above described conduct caused the Respondent's insurance producer license to be suspended in the Respondent's home state; this constitutes a violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(i) and 44-4059(1)(o).

6. Respondent was informed of her right to a public hearing. Respondent waives that right and enters into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily. Respondent

understands and acknowledges that by waiving her right to a public hearing, Respondent also waives her right to confrontation of witnesses, production of evidence, and judicial review.

7. Respondent admits to the allegations in paragraph 3.


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent violated Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(h), 44-4059(1)(i) and 44-4059(1)(o) and is subject to disciplinary action pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4059.


CONSENT ORDER



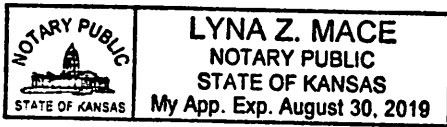
