In order to resolve this matter, the Nebraska Department of Insurance (“Department”), by and through its attorney, Tracy A. Burns, and Claire Ewers (“Respondent”) mutually stipulate and agree as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. The Department has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Respondent pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-101.01 and 44-4047 et seq. (Reissue 2010).
2. Respondent was a licensed non-resident insurance producer under the laws of Nebraska at all times material hereto.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. The Department initiated this administrative proceeding by filing a petition captioned State of Nebraska Department of Insurance vs. Claire Ewers (NAIC National Producer #18046622), Cause No. A-2151, on October 2, 2018.
2. The Department served a copy of the Petition and Notice of Hearing upon the Respondent at Respondent’s registered business address and residence address at 8130 Deepwood Blvd., Apt. D8, Mentor, OH 44060 by certified mail, return receipt requested and regular U.S. mail.

3. Respondent is alleged to have violated Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4059(1)(o) as follows:

a. Respondent's resident insurance producer license became inactive on April 4, 2018 in Respondent's home state of Ohio.

4. Respondent was informed of her right to a public hearing. Respondent waives that right and enters into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily. Respondent understands and acknowledges that by waiving her right to a public hearing, Respondent also waives her right to confrontation of witnesses, production of evidence, and judicial review.


5. Respondent admits to the allegations alleged in paragraph 3.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


Respondent's conduct as alleged above constitutes a violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4059(1)(o).

CONSENT ORDER




