CONSENT ORDER

CAUSE NO. A-2232

In order to resolve this matter, the Nebraska Department of Insurance (“Petitioner”), by and through its attorney, Michael W. Anderson, and Andrew Shader, individually and on behalf of Insurance Pipeline, Inc. (“Respondents”), by and through his attorney, Robby Birnbaum, mutually stipulate and agree as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. Petitioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Respondent pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44.101.01, and 44-4047 to 44-4067.
2. Respondent has been licensed as a non-resident insurance producer under the laws of Nebraska at all times material hereto.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. Petitioner initiated this administrative proceeding by filing a Petition captioned State of Nebraska Department of Insurance vs. Andrew Shader (NAIC National Producer #16590171) & Insurance

Pipeline, Inc. (NAIC National Producer #18539507), Cause Number A-2232 on September 29, 2020. A copy of the Petition was sent to the Respondents at their registered addresses by certified mail, return receipt requested, and by regular U.S. mail. Respondent acknowledges receiving proper Notice of these proceedings.

2. Respondent is alleged to have violated Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059 (1) (g) and 44-1524 (1) as follows:

- a. On August 31, 2020, Petitioner contacted Respondents' office requesting specific information about Respondents' agency and business practices. This request was sent to the email address that was on file for the Respondent at that time, which has subsequently been changed, and Respondent did not timely receive the Petitioner's written inquiry.
- b. Due to the delayed receipt of said inquiry, a response was never received from the Respondents.
- c. After filing of this action, the Respondent did provide a response

3. Respondent admits the allegations in Paragraph 2.

4. Respondent was informed of his right to a public hearing. Respondent waives that right and enters into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily. Respondent understands and acknowledges that by waiving his right to a public hearing, Respondent also waives his right to confrontation of witnesses, production of evidence, and judicial review.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent neither admits nor denies conduct as alleged above in paragraphs a, b, and c. Respondent admits conduct as alleged above constitutes violations of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059 (1) (g) and 44-1524 (1), and Respondent is subject to disciplinary action pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §44-4059.

CONSENT ORDER

It is therefore Ordered by the Director of Insurance and agreed by Respondent that:

1. Respondent agrees to pay an administrative penalty of \$500.
2. The Nebraska Department of Insurance shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purpose of enabling Respondent or the Department of Insurance to make application for further orders as may be necessary should Respondent fail to pay the aforementioned penalty or take the aforementioned actions.
