A public hearing has been scheduled before the Director of Insurance for the State of Nebraska (“Director”) pursuant to *Neb. Rev. Stat.* § 44-6143 to receive information on the Agreement and Plan of Merger (“Merger Agreement”) adopted by the Board of Directors of Medico Mutual Insurance Holding Company (“MMIHC”) on March 8, 2012 and filed with the Director on March 9, 2012.

The public hearing will be held at the Department of Insurance, 941 “O” Street, Suite 400, Lincoln, Nebraska, beginning at 1:30 p.m. Central Daylight Time on April 5, 2012.

A complete copy of the Merger Agreement, with schedules and exhibits, may be examined at the offices of MMIHC, 1515 South 75<sup>th</sup> Street, Omaha, Nebraska 68124 between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 4:45 p.m., Monday through Thursday, and 7:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m., Friday or at [www.gomedico.com](http://www.gomedico.com), and at the office of the Nebraska Insurance Department, 941 “O” Street, Suite 400, Lincoln, Nebraska 68508 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Any interested person may appear or otherwise be heard at the public hearing. Any person wishing to submit a written statement concerning the merger can do so by mailing a copy of that statement to the attention of Bruce R. Ramage, Director of Insurance, 941 “O” Street, Suite 400, Lincoln, Nebraska 68508 prior to April 5, 2012. In order to facilitate the orderly conduct of

the public hearing, any person wishing to make an oral statement at the public hearing should indicate his or her desire to do so by notifying the Director at the above address or by calling 402-471-2201 prior to April 5, 2012.

The public hearing will be conducted pursuant to the Administrative Procedure Act, *Neb. Rev. Stat.* § 84-901 et seq., and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Insurance. Reasonable accommodations will be provided to persons with disabilities upon written request submitted in advance of the hearing.
