Arch Reinsurance Company (“Arch Re”) is a Nebraska domiciled property and casualty insurance company that has applied to the Director of Insurance of the State of Nebraska (“Director”) for approval to redomesticate from Nebraska to Delaware. After reviewing the filings, correspondence, and all pertinent information provided to the Nebraska Department of Insurance (“Department”), the Director hereby approves the application and finds, concludes, and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Arch Re is a Nebraska domiciled property and casualty insurer that was initially licensed in the State of Nebraska on November 6, 1995.
2. Arch Re filed an application to redomesticate from Nebraska to Delaware pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-161 to 44-164 (redomestication provisions) and the provisions of the Nebraska Business Corporation Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 21-2001 to 21-20,197.
3. The application for redomestication is subject to approval of the Director of the Nebraska Department of Insurance and the Delaware Department of Insurance.
4. Arch Re has submitted all documents, information, and filings for the redomestication as required by Nebraska law and the Department.

5. On September 8, 2014, the Delaware Department of Insurance notified the Department that it did not object to Arch Re's redomestication to Delaware.

6. On September 12, 2014, the Department notified the Delaware Department of Insurance that it did not object to Arch Re's redomestication to Delaware, however, unresolved financial examination issues with the Department will be transmitted to the Delaware Department of Insurance for future resolution.

7. Arch Re has provided the Department with copies of its Restated Articles of Incorporation, Certificate of Incorporation, and Certificate of Domestication filed with the Delaware Secretary of State to be effective upon necessary approvals of the Department and the Delaware Department of Insurance.

8. As Arch Re has filed all pertinent and required documents with the Department to support its application, the transfer of Arch Re's domicile from Nebraska to Delaware should be approved.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The State of Nebraska Department of Insurance has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties to this transaction.

2. The approval of this application will not in any manner impair the rights, remedies, or securities of Arch Re's policyholders or creditors.

3. After redomestication, Arch Re will meet all of the requirements for a Certificate of Authority as a foreign property and casualty insurer.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of Arch Reinsurance Company to transfer its domicile from Nebraska to Delaware is hereby approved.

The Nebraska Department of Insurance will issue Arch Reinsurance Company a Certificate of Authority to do business as a foreign insurer in the State of Nebraska, effective as of the date of redomestication.
