#### **New Business**

- Briefing by Department of Insurance staff, Martin Swanson
  - o Feb 12 2014 figures are:
    - i. 20,407 have selected marketplace plan
    - ii. Don't know how many have a contract in place
    - iii. 54% are female, 46% are male
    - iv. 27% are ages 18-34
    - v. 58% have selected Silver
    - vi. 86% have received assistance
    - vii. 1,984 Stand alone dental plan
    - viii. 9,360 Eligible for Medicaid
  - o Federal Government issued proposed dates for companies, dates are not final
  - Between May 26 and June 27<sup>th</sup> application window is open, first data transmission will be August 10, 2014
  - o Prices of plans will not be on display until November
  - o Department continues to do public outreach
    - i. Public Outreach will be a Fraud Outreach video through NET
- Briefing by Department of Health and Human Services staff, Catherine Geekas-Steeby
  - o Presentation and handouts provided, will be available on website

## **Invited Presentations**

- Community Action of Nebraska, Amber Hansen
  - o Handed out a chart of assistance numbers, will be available on website
  - o Reached out to over 25,000 people
  - Issues they are seeing are mostly post enrollment issues
  - Mostly everything is working as it should
  - o Seeing a lot of Medicaid gap
  - Continuing to reach out to youth population, plan on doing direct radio advertising that targets young people
  - o Advertising state wide
  - o Community Action of Nebraska currently has 9 agencies
- Health Center Association of Nebraska, Keisha Bradford
  - Serve 65,000 Annually through 27 locations in Nebraska with a new location in Grand Island
  - Majority of their patients have no insurance
  - o Health centers employ about 39 application counselors
  - 3,300 people filed applications from October 2013 through the end of December 2013
  - o Received federal grant dollars

- BCBS Michelle Lee, Tom Gillsdorff
  - Seen a decrease in data issues, but still seeing issues with the quality of data that is being received
  - There is a lot of consumer confusion, there is not a lot that BCBS can do to help customers
  - o Some data issues are the known problem with the FFM to determine twins.
  - Other issues are change in circumstances functionality, where do consumers go to report concerns. Answers to this continue to change almost weekly if not daily basis.
  - o There is some guidance available as to who to contact when an issue arrives.
  - o Had about 10% enrollment non-payment issues
  - o January enrollment of paid have 5,115 individual members
  - Customer service wait time is a large concern and is being addressed
- Coventry Curt Harms
  - Issues with enrollment and Healthcare.gov are similar with what other issuers are reporting
  - o 1600 Nebraskans signed up for Coventry
  - o Majority of sales have come directly to Coventry
  - Silver plans are the most popular
- CoOportunity Health David Lyons
