In order to resolve this matter, the Nebraska Department of Insurance ("Department"), by and through its attorney, Michael C. Boyd and Joseph D. Sauce, ("Respondent"), mutually stipulate and agree as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. The Department has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Respondent pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §44-101.01 and §44-4047, et seq.
2. Respondent was licensed as a non-resident insurance agent under the laws of Nebraska at all times material hereto. Respondent's registered address with the Department of Insurance is 3114 Summit Street, Sioux City, Iowa 51104.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. The Department initiated this administrative proceeding by filing a petition styled State of Nebraska Department of Insurance vs. Joseph D. Sauce, Cause Number A-1955 on August 28, 2012. A copy of the petition was served upon the Respondent at the Respondent's address registered with the Department by certified mail, return receipt requested and by regular U.S. Mail.

2. Respondent violated Neb. Rev. Stat. §44-4059(1)(b) and Neb. Rev. Stat. §44-4065(3) as a result of the following conduct:

- a. On or about April 15, 2011 the State of Iowa filed a Trial Information in Case No. FECR 056508 against Respondent charging him with committing one Count of Willful Injury in violation of Section 708.4(1) of the Iowa Criminal Code; as well as committing one Count of False Imprisonment in violation of Section 710.7 of the Iowa Criminal Code.
- b. Respondent was arraigned in the District Court of Woodbury County, Iowa on or about April 28, 2011 in Case No. FECR 056508. Respondent did not report the criminal prosecution and arraignment to the director within thirty days of said date.

3. Respondent was informed of his right to a public hearing. Respondent waives that right, and enters into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily. Respondent understands and acknowledges that by waiving his right to a public hearing, Respondent also waives his right to confrontation of witnesses, production of evidence, and judicial review.

4. Respondent admits the allegations contained stated in Paragraph #2 above.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent's conduct as alleged above constitutes a violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. §44-4059(1)(b) and 44-4065(3).

CONSENT ORDER

It is therefore ordered by the Director of Insurance and agreed to by Respondent, Joseph D. Sauce, that Respondent shall pay an administrative fine of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00). The fine shall be paid in total within thirty (30) days from the date the Director of the Department of Insurance affixes his signature to this document and approves said consent agreement. The Nebraska Department of Insurance shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purpose of enabling the Respondent or the Department to make application for such further orders as may be necessary.




