In order to resolve this matter, the Nebraska Department of Insurance (“Department”), by and through its attorney, Matthew W. Holman, and Myron Anthony Owens (“Respondent”), mutually stipulate and agree as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. The Department has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Respondent pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-101.01 and 44-4047 et seq. Said jurisdiction and control have been present at all times material hereto.

2. Myron Anthony Owens (“Respondent”) is a licensed insurance producer, whose current registered business address with the Nebraska Department of Insurance is Strategic Planning, Inc., 875 South 48<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln, Nebraska 68510, and whose current registered home address with the Nebraska Department of Insurance is 11105 William Plaza, Omaha, NE 68144-1874.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. The Department initiated this administrative proceeding by filing a petition styled State of Nebraska Department of Insurance vs. Myron Anthony Owens, Cause Number A-1969, on

December 28, 2012. A copy of the petition was served by certified U.S. mail, return receipted requested, postage prepaid, upon Respondent at the Respondent's registered business mailing address, 875 South 48th Street, Lincoln, Nebraska, 68510, and by regular U.S. mail, postage prepaid, upon Respondent at the Respondent's registered home mailing address of 11105 William Plaza, Omaha, NE 68144-1874.

2. Respondent violated Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(h) and 44-4065(1) as a result of the following conduct set forth below:

a. Respondent Owens signed, on May 14, 2012, a Consent Order with the Nebraska Department of Banking and Finance on behalf of Strategic Legacy Advisors, Inc. ("Strategic"), an investment advisor in the State of Nebraska, and himself.

b. The Consent Order detailed documents Strategic filed, with the advice of counsel, required to be filed with the Department of Banking and Finance by Strategic that were found to be false or misleading in a material respect, and found Strategic in violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 8-1113(9)(a), a section of the Securities Act of Nebraska over which the Nebraska Department of Banking and Finance has jurisdiction. The Department of Banking and Finance did not find violations on the part of the Owens. The Consent Order required Strategic to pay a fine and costs of the investigation.

c. On January 17, 2013, the Respondent Owens reported the above matter to the State of Nebraska Department of Insurance and the insurance departments of the states of Arizona, Colorado, Georgia, Iowa, Kansas, Maryland, Missouri, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, Texas and Virginia through the National Insurance Producer registry.

d. Respondent Owens did not report this action within thirty days of its final disposition, as required by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4065.

3. Respondent Owens was informed of his right to a public hearing. Respondent waives that right, and enters into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily. Respondent understands and acknowledges that by waiving the right to a public hearing, Respondent also waives the right to confrontation of witnesses, production of evidence, and judicial review.

4. Respondent admits the allegations stated in Paragraph 2.

5. Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4059(5) (Reissue 2010) provides that “The director shall retain the authority to enforce the provisions of and impose any penalty or remedy authorized by the Insurance Producers Licensing Act against any person who is under investigation for or charged with a violation of the act even if the person's license or registration has been surrendered or has lapsed by operation of law. No disciplinary proceeding shall be instituted against any licensed person after the expiration of three years from the termination of such license.”

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


Respondent's conduct as alleged above constitutes a violation of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1) and 44-4065(1) and is subject to disciplinary action pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4059.

#### CONSENT ORDER

It is therefore ordered by the Director of Insurance and agreed by Respondent, Myron Anthony Owens, that Respondent shall pay an administrative fine in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00), due within 30 days after the Director of Insurance or his designee approves and signs this consent order.

The Department of Insurance will continue to retain jurisdiction over this matter. If Respondent fails to pay the amount required as specified under this consent order, additional administrative action shall be taken by the Petitioner, which may include revocation of Respondent's Nebraska insurance producer license. In witness of their intention to be bound by this Consent Order, each party has executed this document by subscribing his/her signature below.


