CONSENT ORDER

In order to resolve this matter, the Nebraska Department of Insurance (“Department”), by and through its attorney, Robert M. Bell, and Matthew Spawn (“Respondent”) mutually stipulate and agree as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. The Department has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Respondent pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-101.01 and the Insurance Producers Licensing Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4047 to 4067.

2. Respondent is a licensed insurance producer under the laws of Nebraska at all times material hereto.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. The Department initiated this administrative proceeding by filing a Petition and Notice of Hearing captioned *State of Nebraska Department of Insurance vs. Matthew Spawn*, Cause No. A-2007, on November 3, 2014.

2. The Department mailed a copy of the Petition and Notice of Hearing to the business address Respondent registered with the Department, 1470 25<sup>th</sup> Ave. Columbus, Nebraska 68601-4912, and home address Respondent registered with the Department, 1860 E. Calle

Colombo, P.O Box 741, Columbus, Nebraska 68601-0741. Respondent received a copy of the Petition and Notice of Hearing.

3. Respondent violated Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-5905(2)(b)(i)(A) and § 44-4059(1)(b) as follows:

a. On or about November 1, 2013, the Columbus Police Department was contacted regarding a report of documents 'blowing around' in an alley near Respondent's business. The documents included portions of both Ruth Hansen's and Melvin Janicek's Medicare Supplement policy applications and electronic fund transfer forms that were to be retained by Respondent.

4. Respondent was informed of his right to a public hearing. Respondent waives that right and enters into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily. Respondent understands and acknowledges that by waiving his right to a public hearing, Respondent also waives his right to confrontation of witnesses, production of evidence, and judicial review.

5. Respondent admits the allegations set forth in paragraph 3 of this section are true and accurate. Respondent consents to the revocation of his Nebraska insurance producer license, #8424221.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondent violated Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(b) and 44-5905(2)(b)(i)(A) and is subject to disciplinary action pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4059.

#### CONSENT ORDER

It is therefore ordered by the Director of Insurance and agreed by the Respondent, Matthew Spawn, that Respondent's Nebraska insurance producer license #8424221 shall be


