In order to resolve this matter, the Nebraska Department of Insurance (“Department”), by and through its attorney, Krystle Ledvina Garcia, and Kristian Baso (“Respondent”), mutually stipulate and agree as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. The Department has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Respondent pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-101.01, and 44-4047 to 44-4067 (Reissue 2010).

2. Respondent was licensed as an insurance producer under the laws of Nebraska at all times material hereto.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. The Department initiated this administrative proceeding by filing a petition styled State of Nebraska Department of Insurance vs. Kristian Baso (NAIC National Producer # 16309292), Cause Number A-2031 on February 8, 2016. A copy of the petition was served upon the Respondent at Respondent’s registered business by certified mail, return receipt requested, and Respondent’s home addresses by regular U.S. mail.

2. Respondent is alleged to have violated Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(a), 44-4059(1)(b), 44-4059(1)(h) and 44-4059(1)(i) (Reissue 2010) as follows:

- a. On or about October 25, 1991, in the Supreme Court of the State of New York, County of Richmond, Respondent entered a plea of guilty and was convicted of Attempted Robbery in the Second Degree, a Class C Felony, in Case No. RS9150427. The conviction was listed under the alias Kristian Basolamas. He was sentenced to five years probation which was favorably terminated on or about September 25, 1995.
- b. On or about November 15, 1991, in the Criminal Division of the Circuit Court of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, for Palm Beach County, Respondent entered a plea of guilty and was convicted of three counts of Battery, First Degree Misdemeanor, in Case No. 01-8365 CF. The conviction was listed under the alias Kristian Basolamas. He was sentenced to six days in jail and order to pay restitution in the amount of \$2,810.
- c. On or about July 28, 2011, Respondent applied for a Nebraska non-resident producer license. Respondent answered “no” to Background Question 1 on the application which specifically states: “Have you ever been convicted of a crime, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a crime. ‘Crime’ includes a misdemeanor, felony, or military offense.”
- d. On or about December 7, 2011, and December 3, 2013, Respondent submitted a renewal application for his Nebraska non-resident producer license. Respondent answered “no” to Background Question 1 on the application which specifically states: “Have you been convicted of a crime, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a crime, which has not been previously reported to this insurance department.”
- e. On or about August 5, 2015, the California Department of Insurance issued an order revoking Respondent’s non-resident insurance producer license for failing to disclose his criminal convictions on the license application.
- f. On or about November 2, 2015, the Kentucky Department of Insurance issued an order revoking Respondent’s non-resident insurance producer license for failing to disclose his criminal convictions on the license application.
- g. Respondent failed to report his two convictions in 1991 to the Department on his initial resident insurance producer’s application as well as his renewal applications.

3. Respondent was informed of his right to a public hearing. Respondent waives that right and enters into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily. Respondent understands and acknowledges that by waiving his right to a public hearing, Respondent also waives his right to confrontation of witnesses, production of evidence, and judicial review.

4. Respondent admits the allegations stated in Paragraph 2.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


Respondent's conduct as alleged above constitutes violations of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(a), 44-4059(1)(b), 44-4059(1)(h) and 44-4059(1)(i) (Reissue 2010).

CONSENT ORDER

It is therefore ordered by the Director of Insurance and agreed by Respondent, Kristian Baso, that:

1. Respondent shall pay an administrative fine in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) due within 30 days after the Director of Insurance or his designee approves and signs this consent order. If Respondent fails to pay the amount required under this consent order within the time specified, additional administrative action shall be taken by the Petitioner, which shall include revocation of Respondent's insurance producer license.


