In order to resolve this matter, the Nebraska Department of Insurance ("Department"), by and through its attorney, Matthew W. Holman, National Brokers of America, Inc. ("Respondent NBA"), and Alan Christopher Redmond ("Respondent Redmond") mutually stipulate and agree as follows:

JURISDICTION

- 1. The Department has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Respondents pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-101.01, and 44-4047 to 44-4067.
2. Respondents were licensed as an insurance agency and an insurance producer under the laws of Nebraska at all times material hereto.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

- 1. The Department initiated this administrative proceeding by filing a petition styled State of Nebraska Department of Insurance v. National Brokers of America, Inc. (NAIC Producer #16919340), and Alan Christopher Redmond (NAIC Producer #9210093), Cause Number A-2075

on June 6, 2017. A copy of the petition was served upon the Respondents at Respondents' registered business address by certified mail, return receipt requested, and by regular U.S. mail.

2. Pursuant to the Petition, Respondents are alleged to have violated Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(b), 44-4059(1)(h), 44-4059(1)(i), and 44-4065(1) as follows:

- a. On or about January 6, 2017, Respondent NBA's Louisiana Insurance Producer license was revoked.
- b. On or about April 19, 2017, Respondent NBA, after being questioned by the Nebraska Department of Insurance, notified the Nebraska Department of Insurance about the Louisiana revocation. This was more than thirty days after final disposition of the matter.

3. Respondents were informed of their right to a public hearing. Respondents waive that right and enter into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily. Respondents understand and acknowledge that by waiving the right to a public hearing, Respondents also waive the right to confrontation of witnesses, production of evidence, and judicial review.

4. Respondent admits the allegations outlined in the Petition.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Respondents' conduct as alleged in the Petition constitutes violations of the Nebraska Insurance Producer Licensing Act.
