CONSENT ORDER

In order to resolve this matter, the Nebraska Department of Insurance (“Department”), by and through its attorney, Tracy A. Burns, and Rebecca L. Marble mutually stipulate and agree as follows:

JURISDICTION

1. The Department has jurisdiction over the subject matter and Respondent pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-101.01 and 44-4047 et seq. (Reissue 2010).
2. Respondent was licensed as an insurance producer under the laws of Nebraska at all times hereto.

STIPULATIONS OF FACT

1. The Department initiated this administrative proceeding by filing a petition styled State of Nebraska Department of Insurance vs. Rebecca L. Marble (NAIC National Producer #18739171) on April 4, 2019. A copy of the petition was served upon the Respondent at Respondent’s registered business and residence address by certified mail, return receipt requested. On April 12, 2019, a copy of the amended petition was served upon the Respondent

at Respondent's registered business and residence address by certified mail, return receipt requested. Respondent acknowledges receiving proper Notice of these proceedings.

2. Respondent violated Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(a), 44-4059(1)(b), 44-4059(1)(h), and 44-4065(1) as follows:

- a. On or about February 20, 2003, Respondent obtained a Nebraska Real Estate Broker license.
- b. On or about June 12, 2017, a Complaint was filed against Respondent by the Nebraska Real Estate Commission, in part, for failure to disclose an adverse material fact regarding the condition of a parcel of real estate.
- c. On or about March 26, 2018, Respondent completed an application for a Nebraska resident insurance producer license. She responded "no" to the background question asking, "Have you ever been named or involved as a party in an administrative proceeding, including FINRA sanction or arbitration proceeding regarding any professional or occupational license or registration?"
- d. On or about March 26, 2018, Respondent was granted a resident insurance producer license.
- e. On or about November 13, 2018, a Stipulation and Consent Order was entered in the real estate action.
- f. On or about February 5, 2019, Respondent completed an insurance producer renewal application. The application included a "yes" response to the background question, "Have you ever been named or involved as a party in an administrative proceeding, including FINRA sanction or arbitration proceeding regarding any professional or occupational license or registration?" Documents relevant to the action were uploaded to the NIPR warehouse.
- g. As of March 1, 2019, Respondent's resident insurance producer license is active.

3. Respondent admits the allegations in Paragraph 2.

4. Respondent was informed of her right to a public hearing. Respondent waives that right and enters into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily. Respondent understands and acknowledges that by waiving her right to a public hearing, she also waives her right to confrontation of witnesses, production of evidence, and judicial review.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


Respondent's conduct as alleged above constitutes violations of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 44-4059(1)(a), 44-4059(1)(b), 44-4059(1)(h), and 44-4065(1) and Respondent is subject to disciplinary action pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 44-4059.

CONSENT ORDER


It is therefore ordered by the Director of Insurance and agreed by Respondent, Rebecca L. Marble, that:

1. Respondent agrees to pay an administrative fine of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) within thirty (30) days of the adoption of this Consent Order by the Director. Respondent also agrees that her resident insurance producer's license shall be immediately suspended if Respondent fails to pay the administrative fine within the thirty (30) days of the adoption of the Consent Order, and that said suspension shall continue indefinitely until the administrative fine is paid in full.
