§ 001. Authority

This rule is promulgated pursuant to the authority of *Neb.Rev.Stat.* §44-101.01 and the Comprehensive Health Insurance Pool Act, §§44-4201 through 44-4235.

§ 002. Purpose

The purpose of this rule is to set forth eligibility requirements and criteria for selection of the Individual who will serve on the Board of Directors of the Comprehensive Health Insurance Pool as a representative of a health agency which is involved in advocating for persons with special health care needs.

§ 003. Definitions.

The definitions set forth in *Neb.Rev.Stat.* §§44-4204 through 44-4216 shall be used unless the context otherwise requires.

§004 Eligibility and selection criteria

(004.01) The member of the Board of Directors of the Comprehensive Health Insurance Pool serving as the representative of the health agency shall:

(004.01A) Be a resident of Nebraska.

(004.01B) Not be a member of the board of directors, an officer, or an employee of an insurer, and

(004.01B~~C~~) Be a representative of a recognized health agency who will effectively represent the interests of persons with special health care needs who will be eligible under the Comprehensive Health Insurance Pool.
